- Presenters agree to present in English or ASL at a moderate pace to allow access to all audience members. Your presentation will be translated in real time via visual and tactile sign language interpreters and CART transcribers
- Any slides included in a presentation must be described during the presentation for non-visual audience members.
- Invited speakers will have their registration fees waived.
- Up to two nights of hotel accommodations (July 12 and 13) will be provided at no cost to speakers by the Usher Syndrome Coalition at the conference venue.
- Presenters are responsible for their own travel arrangements.
- Presenters do not receive a stipend from the Usher Syndrome Coalition.
